




St. Anne's Primary School

- **St Anne's website has been updated** with details of events happening throughout the year. Further updates will be made as the year progresses. Please remember that some arrangements may change at short notice.
- Please remember that St Anne's Primary School is a **"NUT FREE ZONE"**.
- Could all **P7s** wishing to take part in our **residential to Carlingford** in May, please return the reply slip and deposit as soon as possible. We must confirm the numbers attending and pay a deposit this week to secure our place.
- **P1 children** will finish at 1 pm on week beginning Monday 19th September. They will therefore need to bring a lunch/pay for dinner. On these days pupils can be picked up from the front playground or Sports Hall (if raining). From week 5 (week beginning Monday 26th September) P1 children will stay until 2 pm and will be walked to the school gate where they can be collected or avail of the school/after school bus.
- **P2 pupils will finish at 2pm every day. P3 will finish school at 2.50 pm Monday –Thursday and at 2 pm on a Friday.** Pupils will be walked to the school gate where they can be collected or avail of the school/after school bus.
- **P4–P7 After Schools Basketball** will begin on Wednesday 28th September, 3.00pm to 4.00pm for 5 weeks. Please complete the reply slip attached if you wish your child to attend. There is a limit of 20 places available so first come first served.
- **A meeting of the PTA** will be held in the school on Wednesday 21st September at **8.30 pm**. All new and existing members are encouraged to attend.
