As we need to know numbers for Monday can we ask that this is sent to school, when possible, on the Friday before. Parents please note that supervision for children who are not attending the Breakfast club begins at 8.50am; children will not be permitted to enter the school building before this time.

- Loughguile Credit Union—Remember to send in your child's savings (max £2) on a Wednesday in the folder provided. The annual Credit Union Art Competition has been launched.
