As we need to know numbers for Monday can we ask that this is sent to school, when possible, on the Friday before. Parents please note that supervision for children who are not attending the Breakfast club begins at 8.50am; children will not be permitted to enter the school building before this time.
- Brain Gym for pupils who are sitting the Transfer Test in 2017 only, will continue every Tuesday from 2.50-4.00pm.
