As we need to know numbers for Monday can we ask that this is sent to school, when possible, on the Friday before. ***Parents please note that supervision for children who are not attending the Breakfast club begins at 8.50am; children will not be permitted to enter the school building before this time.***

It's not too late if you would like to enrol your child/children for any of the activities, please complete the permission slips, along with the appropriate fee and return to school as soon as possible.
