- After School Clubs 2017 Due to the cold weather and the Christmas Show, the last week of after school clubs had to be cancelled. To make up for this lost week, the Cross Country club will be held on Friday 12th January and Thursday 18th January from 3.00-4.00pm. These two sessions will be in preparation for our final cross country competition, due to take place on Wednesday 24th January. Irish class will be held on Monday 15th January from 3.00-4.00pm and Hurling and Camogie will be on Wednesday 17th January from 3.00-4.00pm. Parents are reminded that they will have to collect their children at these times as there will be no school bus available.

The clubs have been based on feedback we received from the questionnaire sent to parents at the beginning of the school year. Clubs will again be limited to 20 participants. If you wish your child/children to attend the breakfast club please send £2 per day in an envelope with your child's name and days they wish to take breakfast. As we need to know numbers for Monday can we ask that this is sent to school, when possible, on the Friday before. Parents please note that supervision for children who are not attending the Breakfast club begins at 8.50am; children will not be permitted to enter the school building before this time.
- Swimming P6/7 will continue as usual on Wednesday. The cost is £3 per child per week.

- Our new Text Parents service has been set up. One message will be sent to the parent who is listed as Priority 1 on the Pupil Data Sheet. If any details change, please inform the school as soon as possible.
