- **Mid-Term Break**—The school will close at 2pm for all pupils on Friday 9th February and re-open on Monday 19th February.
- **School Milk**—If you wish / do not wish your child / children to have school milk for March & April, please complete the attached slip and return it to the school along with £7.56 on or before **Tuesday 20th February**.
- **After School Sports** with Mark McKane (Active Communities Coach) will commence on Thursday 22nd February and continue for 5 weeks. P1 & P2 pupils can enrol for Multi Sports. The cost is £2 per session and will run from 2.00pm-3.00pm. P3—P7 pupils can enrol for Table Tennis. The cost is also £2 per session and will run from 3.00-4.00pm. Parents will have to arrange to collect their children from the later session as there will be no buses available. Children should bring their PE gear to school with them. Where more than 20 pupils apply, we will select pupils for this term and ensure that those who missed out will be on the next rotation. Permission slips for both events are attached.
- **Curricular Rugby with Ulster Rugby coach Tommy Van Wyk** will continue every Monday for P4-P7 pupils. These classes will run until Easter. Please ensure that all pupils have their PE kit with them.
- **Shared Education Hurling & Hockey Lessons** for P6 & P7 Pupils will begin on Friday 23rd February in Dunloy Sports Academy, concluding on 16th March. All pupils must bring their PE gear with them, along with sticks & helmets. This is part of our continued commitment to Shared Education with our partner school, Knockahollet P.S.

- **St Anne's Breakfast Club** will continue as usual from 8.00am until 8.50am every morning until the end of the year. **P1 children may now attend.** If you wish your child/children to attend the breakfast club please send £2 per day in an envelope with your child's name and days they wish to take breakfast. As we need to know numbers for Monday can we ask that this is sent to school, when possible, on the Friday before. ***Parents please note that supervision for children who are not attending the Breakfast club begins at 8.50am; children will not be permitted to enter the school building before this time.***
- **P1-P7 PE Lessons** are held every **Monday**. Please ensure all pupils bring their PE gear to school with them.
- **Swimming** - P6/7 will continue as usual on Wednesday. The cost is £3 per child per week.
- **Loughguile Credit Union**—Remember to send in your child's savings (max £2) on a Wednesday in the folder provided.
- **Free School Meals**—If anyone requires an application form for Free School Meals / School Uniform / Physical Education Allowance, please contact the school office
- Our new **Text Parents** service has been set up. One message will be sent to the parent who is listed as Priority 1 on the Pupil Data Sheet. If any details change, please inform the school as soon as possible.
