- Welcome back to a new school term We hope you had a lovely break.
- The Service of Light and Commitment will take place on Thursday 15th March at 7pm. All P7 pupils are to wear full school uniform.

- After School Sports will begin on Thursday 22nd February from 2pm to 3pm for the P1 and P2 children (Multi Sports) and from 3pm to 4pm for the older children (Table Tennis). Children should bring their PE gear to school with them. There are spaces still available so its not too late to enrol! Permission slips are available to print from the school website. Parents will have to arrange to collect their children from the later session as there will be no buses available.
- Shared Education Hurling & Hockey Lessons for P6 & P7 Pupils will begin on Friday 23rd February in Dunloy Sports Academy, concluding on 16th March. All pupils must bring their PE gear with them, along with sticks & helmets.
- World Book Day will be celebrated by all pupils at St Anne's on Thursday 1st March. Children can dress up as their favourite book character. The cost will be £1 per child or £2 per family with all proceeds going to Trocaire. There will be a competition for each class, with prizes for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place for pupils who participate in one or more of the following:
- A picture of you reading your favourite book in a strange place.
- A model of your favourite book character (less than 30cm high).
- A video of you reading an extract from your favourite book. Children should practice at home and the recording will be in school. Teachers will provide guidance to the pupils about the structure of the video
