School Dinners

 The price of a school meal is £2.60 per day or £13.00 per week. Dinners for the week (paid and free) should be ordered on a Monday morning by returning the correct money and slip attached

Collection of Children

 Class Teachers should be informed of any changes to arrangements for collecting children.

- 8.00am until 8.50am every morning until the end of the year. If you wish your child/children to attend the breakfast club please send £2 per day in an envelope with your child's name and days they wish to take breakfast. As we need to know numbers for Monday can we ask that this is sent to school, when possible, on the Friday before. Parents please note that supervision for children who are not attending the Breakfast club begins at 8.50am; children will not be permitted to enter the school building before this time.
- After school clubs 2020 are well under way. These will run until Half Term in February. Hurling/Camogie is on Mondays, Art & Craft on Tuesdays, Cultural Club on Wednesdays and Table Tennis and ICT on Thursdays.
- School absences must be reported in writing to your child's teacher as soon as possible, usually on your child's return to school. This ensures the correct absence code can be entered to the official attendance register.
- Swimming Lessons will continue every Wednesday for our P5 and P6 pupils until Mid Term. The cost is £3 per child per week. P7 lessons will commence after mid term.
- School Dinner—A menu for next week's dinners is attached. Please complete and return with the money if applicable by <u>Monday morning at the latest</u>. As the dinners are prepared in St Patrick's kitchen, the cooks need to know the numbers in advance.
- DVDs of our Christmas Show are still available to purchase from the school. The cost is £2 per disc.
- Peace Proms— To avoid disappointment, please book your tickets as soon as possible. When booking, family members of St Anne's are in the West Tier.
