- Parents must inform the school of any changes to home travel arrangements as soon as possible. Please take steps to ensure any messages sent to staff within 24 hours of a change to collection arrangements have been received.
- Swimming for P7 will continue every Wednesday. The cost will continue at £3.00 per child per week.
- School Dinner—An online menu order for next week is available to complete on the school website early next week. After completion, please send the fee in an envelope with your child's name on it by Monday morning. As the dinners are prepared in St Patrick's kitchen, the cooks need to know the numbers in advance. Due to kitchen staff shortages, they are only able to offer a packed lunch for next week. They hope to be able to resume hot school dinners as soon as possible and apologise to everyone for the inconvenience.
- COVID-19—due to increasing numbers of Covid positive cases in our school, letters from the PHA have been posted to our Home Learning webpages. We remind parents to remain vigilant for COVID-19 symptoms and encourage good hand washing and sanitizing practices. If your child tests positive for COVID-19, please inform the school as soon as possible, so that we can relay this information to the PHA.
